

The status of the planned improvements for SR-109 from I-40 in Wilson County to SR-52 in Portland as of October 15, 2008:

- **SR-109 from I-40 to Lebanon Rd. (Wilson County)** - Construction bids for this section were opened Friday, September 19, 2008. Construction is estimated to begin in late fall for this section. This section will be widened from the existing 2 lanes to 4 lanes.
- **SR-109 from Lebanon Rd. to the Cumberland River Bridge (Wilson County)** - Environmental document is underway. No current funding for any other phase.
- **SR-109 from Cumberland River Bridge to SR-109 Bypass (Sumner County)** - Environmental document is underway. ROW is budgeted.
- **SR-109 from Gallatin Bypass, North of Gallatin to Hollis Chapel Road (Sumner County)**- Stage Construction is underway; Paving funds are included in the current budget.
- **SR-109 from Hollis Chapel Road to SR-76 (Sumner County)** - ROW acquisition is underway; Construction will have to be considered in a future budget.
- **SR-109 from SR-76 to SR-52 in Portland (Sumner County)** - Construction is underway.
